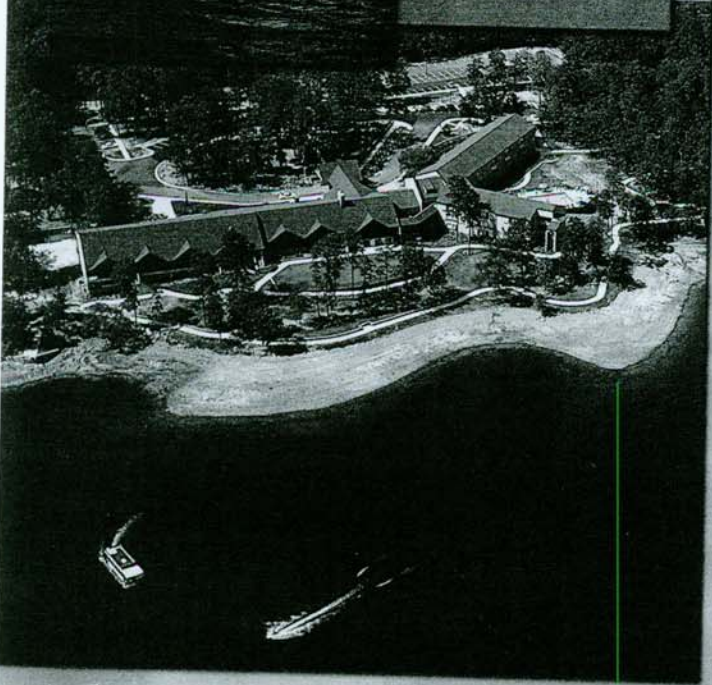


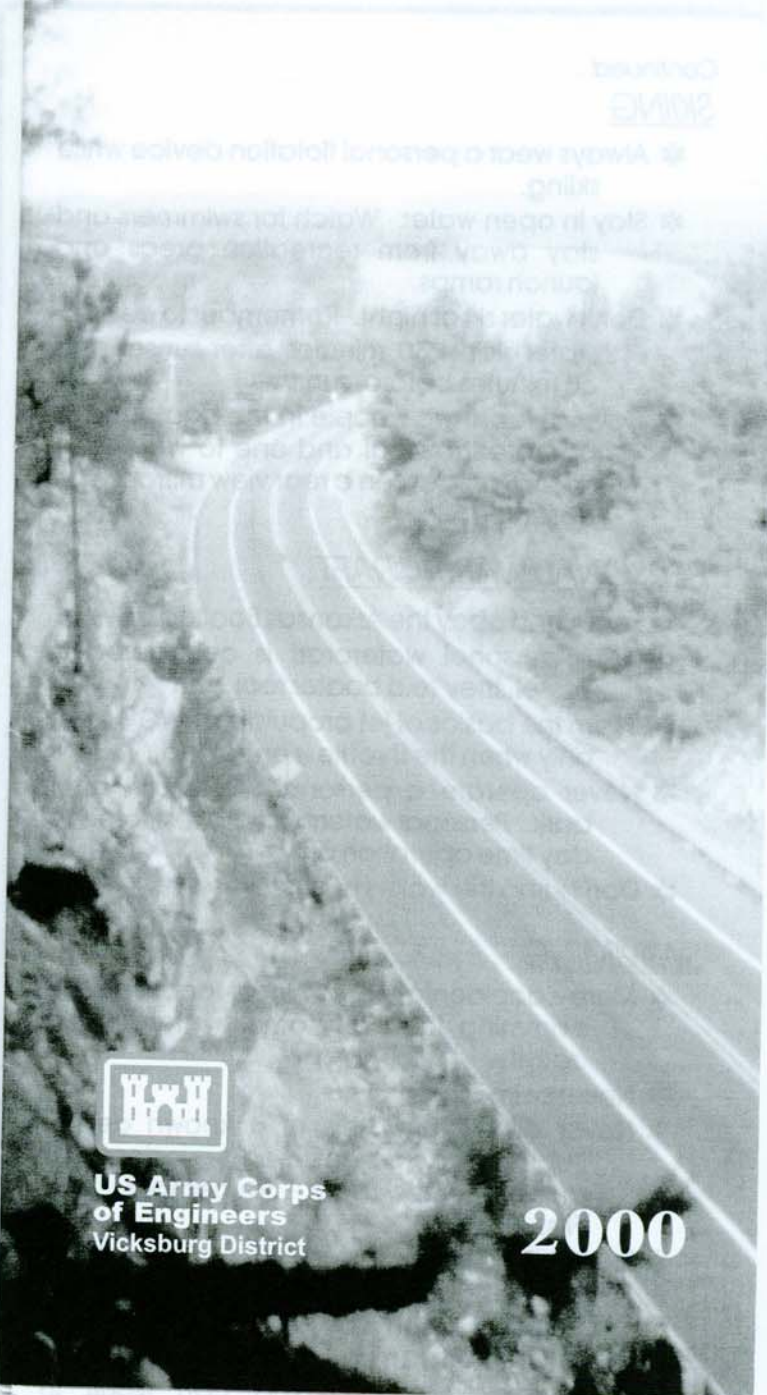

## SKIING

- \* Always wear a personal flotation device while skiing.
- \* Stay in open water. Watch for swimmers and stay away from recreation areas and launch ramps.
- \* Don't water ski at night. Remember to cease water skiing 30 minutes after sunset and 30 minutes before sunrise.
- \* Have at least two people in the boat, one to operate the boat and one to watch the skier. Don't rely on a rear view mirror as an observer.

## PERSONAL WATERCRAFT

- \* Learn and obey the Arkansas Boating Laws. A personal watercraft is considered a vessel, they're a boater too!
- \* Learn the basics of jet propulsion. PWC's steer only when the throttle is engaged.
- \* Never operate a personal watercraft after dark. Personal watercraft are restricted to day time operation only.
- \* Don't jump the wakes of other vessels.

## SWIMMING

- \* More accidental drownings occur while swimming than any other water-related activity.
- \* Never swim alone.
- \* Never dive into waters of unknown depth. Submerged objects and underwater currents are deadly. Remember "Feet First, First Time."
- \* Watch children closely.
- \* Swim in designated swimming areas only. Swimmers should avoid boating channels and launch ramps.
- \* Horseplay while swimming can result in injuries and even death.
- \* Know your limitations. Don't let peer pressure push you beyond your swimming abilities.
